Highway	Location	Length (km)	Timing	Improvement
17B	Intersection of Highway 17 and 17B in Sault Ste. Marie to Highway 17 and Bar River Road East	20.7	2018	Repave existing fully paved shoulders for 19 km; Add fully paved shoulders at east end for 1.7 km
17	James Street (Iron Bridge) to Hudson Street (Blind River)	23.1	2016	Fully paved shoulders
17	Trail on north side of Highway 17 from Birchwood Circle (Blind River) to Air Service Road (North Shore)	2.4	2017	Implement improvements based on MTO review recommendations
17	Highway 538 to west junction of Highway 17 and Martin Road (Northshore)	12.7	2017	Fully paved shoulders

Highway	Location	Length (km)	Timing	Improvement
17	East junction of Highway 17 and Martin Road (Northshore) to Riverview Road (Northshore)	0.82	2017	Fully paved shoulders
17	River Road to Village Road West	2.1	2017	Fully paved shoulders
17	<i>DeClerk Road/Menard Crescent (Spanish) to River Road (Walford)</i>	6.3	2017	<i>Fully paved shoulders</i>
17	Jacklin Road to Old Nairn Road (Nairn Centre)	6.5	2016	Fully paved shoulders
6	Espanola to Highway 17	2.7	2017	Fully paved shoulders
