This letter will serve to confirm the routing as outlined in the GPS shape files for the Lake Huron North Channel Waterfront Trail along both roadways and/or off-road trail facilities will be recognized as part of the overall Trans Canada Trail within the Township of the North Shore.

Our community has worked with the Waterfront Regeneration Trust (WRT) and Tourism Northern Ontario to identify and implement a roadway route through our community which is reflected in the attached maps and completed roadway form. We will continue to work with the WRT to implement the Route and install signage in time for the Trans Canada Trail completion and 150th celebration by July 2017.

The 370 km LHNC will travel through one of the most beautiful and ecologically important landscapes in Canada, and will connect the LHNC to the TCT trail network, and over 1,000 communities across Canada! We are pleased to be able to add the Trans Canada Trail to our local trail network and supports: healthy living, connecting with our environments, economic development, and opportunities for education on our cultural and natural histories.
